Roc Doc Rear Axle U Bolt Skidz Installation Instructions

- 1. Raise the rear of the vehicle with a hoist or jack and place stands under the frame.
- 2. Install these parts one side at a time. Support the leaf spring with a jack stand to prevent suspension travel when you remove the four nuts and lock washers from the 2 U Bolts.
- 3. Before you remove any of the U Bolt nuts, we suggest you use a tie down strap wrapped around the U Bolt Plate to hold the U Bolt bottom Plate in position against the bottom of the leaf spring when the nuts are removed from the U Bolts. Remove the four U Bolt Nuts and Lock Washers.
- 4. Place the correct U Bolt Skid in position and loosely start the U Bolt Nuts with a Lock Washer on each. The U Bolt Skid is installed with the straight edge toward the tire and the curved side of the shield towards the differential to protect the shock mount.
- 5. Remove the tie down strap holding the U Bolt Plate. Tighten the U Bolt nuts progressively in a crisscross pattern to maintain correct alignment of the U Bolt Skid and torque to 56 ft-lbs.
- 6. Repeat these same steps for the other side U Bolt Skid.
- 7. IMPORTANT: Re-torque the U Bolts Nuts in a crisscross pattern after no more than 20 miles of driving following step 6.
